The two highlighted rows are actually the same file. I've verified on both workstations that they are identically named, with identical time-stamps, and identical sizes. However, BestSync (with the file name encryption option) is somehow confused in this case. The 2nd highlighted row appears to be erroneous.

The filename that BestSync wants to copy to folder 1 is mangled. The file name should be "mru-most-recently-used-switching.html". However, BestSync wants to copy a file from folder 2 to folder 1 named "mru-most-recently-~.html"

The file time-stamp is identical (as it should be), but the file size is different. The correct file size is the 16,376. BestSync is incorrectly computing the file size in folder 2 to be 7,286.
